Authority for the General Manager, Los Angeles Department of Transportation, and General Manager, Department of City Planning, in consultation with first responders, to jointly establish and/or revise Citywide Mobility corridors and Neighborhood Mobility Corridors. The General Managers shall consult with stakeholders prior to establishing or revising any corridor designations. The General Managers shall certify that for each segment revision, that segment has been replaced with an alternative segment of equal or greater comfort, safety, and utility for the affected class of road users.
