SUBJECT:

Initiation of Vacation Proceedings - Alley South of Wilshire Boulevard Between Coronado Street and Carondelet Street - VAC - E1401424

RECOMMENDATIONS:

- A. That upon adoption of this report, the vacation proceeding to vacate the alley south of Wilshire Boulevard between Coronado Street and Carondelet Street, as shown on Exhibit A, be initiated pursuant to California Streets and Highways Code, Division 9, Part 3, Public Streets, Highways and Service Easements Vacation Law.
- B. That the Bureau of Engineering be directed to investigate the feasibility of this vacation request.
- C. That the Bureau of Engineering present its report regarding the feasibility of vacating the requested area to the Public Works Committee.

FISCAL IMPACT STATEMENT:

A deposit of \$14,980.00 was paid by the petitioner for the investigation of this request pursuant to Section 7.42 of the Administrative Code. Any deficit fee to recover the cost pursuant to Section 7.44 of the Administrative Code will be required of the petitioner.
