Billy Chun has over two decades of experience in economic development projects and investment deals throughout the country.

Mr. Chun currently serves as an investment and social impact advisor to a family office, high net worth individuals and early-stage companies.

Previously, Mr. Chun served as deputy mayor of economic development and led the business team for Mayor Eric Garcetti. In addition to overseeing seven city departments, he was charged with growing a prosperous and inclusive economy by creating jobs, attracting investment and increasing tourism. He has worked on key initiatives such as raising the minimum wage, reforming the business tax, creating the Mayor's Tech Council and launching the Evolve Entertainment Fund and Urban Movement Labs. He also led the City's recruitment of Netflix (Hollywood), Honest Company (Playa Vista), Warner Music Group (Arts District), and the Amazon HQ2 bid.

Before joining the Mayor's Office in 2013, Mr. Chun was Vice President at Capri Capital, a private equity and investment manager with almost \$4 billion of assets under management. He was responsible for sourcing and underwriting acquisitions, asset management and equity investment activities including origination, direct and joint venture investing.

Prior to Capri Capital, he was at the Community Redevelopment Agency/LA and at CBRE's consulting group (NYSE: CBRE).

Should this apply to your Commission, you will be receiving a packet from the City Ethics Commission containing information about the City's conflict of interest laws, and a copy of the State Form 700/Statement of Economic Interests. You are required to complete and return this form **within 21 days** of your nomination to the City Ethics Commission at 200 North Spring Street, City Hall, 24th Floor, Los Angeles, California 90012.
