The First-In Foundation has graciously donated two commercial-grade washers and three commercial-grade dryers from Park La Brea and WASH to Fire Station 61. Currently, Fire Station 61 has two old household washers and three household-style dryers. Replacing these appliances with two new robust and reliable commercial washers and dryers would benefit the members in efficiently maintaining clean uniforms, workout clothing, dish towels and more. The donated items would improve the quality of life for members of Fire Station 61. The value of this donation is estimated at \$8,858.

RECOMMENDATIONS

1. Receive this report for the In-Kind Donation by First-In Fire Foundation for the items listed above, valued at \$8,858. to the Los Angeles Fire Department.

FISCAL IMPACT

SUMMARY

Fire Station 61 Commanders are requesting permission to accept a donation of two commercial grade washers and three commercial grade dryers from Park La Brea and WASH through the First-In Fire Foundation.

RECOMMENDATION

It is respectfully recommended that the Board of Fire Commissioners approve the request to accept the donation of the commercial washers and dryers.

FINDINGS

Fire Station 61 does currently have two old household style washers and three household style dryers. Replacing these appliances with two new robust and reliable commercial washers and three commercial dryers would benefit the members of Fire Station 61. The appliances are identified as:

Washer - Speed Queen Quantum Gold Pro top load washers Model
#SWNNY2SP116TW01 at a valued cost of \$2017 per washer.

Dryer - Speed Queen Quantum Gold Pro rear control single dryers Model
#DGNYRGS116TW01 at a value cost of \$1608 per dryer.

Total Donation Value - 2 X \$2017 + 3 X \$1608 = \$8,858

A small "city" housing up to 12,000 residents, the Park La Brea community frequently calls upon the members of Fire Station 61 to respond and mitigate their medical and fire related incidents. The Park La Brea management company has expressed sincere gratitude for Fire Station 61's consistent exceptional service and upon a station visit offered to replace 61's old washer and dryer appliances with rugged and commercial type appliances commonly used throughout the Park La Brea property and supplied by the WASH company. Tested to be reliable in Park La Brea, these donated appliances would improve the quality of life for the members of Fire Station 61.

As the donation would be a one for one replacement of existing house due paid for appliances, it has been verified that the donation of the washers and dryers will not incur any city costs or maintenance other than the cost to power the efficient appliances.

CONCLUSION

Having two reliable commercial grade washers and three dryers would greatly assist the members working at Fire Station 61 in efficiently maintaining clean uniforms, workout clothing, dish towels, etc. The members at Fire Station 61 are grateful for the opportunity to accept such a useful donation by Park La Brea and WASH through the First-In Fire Foundation. SUMMARY

Fire Station 61 Commanders are requesting permission to accept and utilize an appliance donation from Park La Brea and WASH through the First-In Fire Foundation. The donation consists of two washers and three dryers that are commercial grade.





RECOMMENDATION

It is respectfully recommended that the Board of Fire Commissioners approve the request to accept the donation of the commercial washers and dryers.

FINDINGS

Fire Station 61 currently have two household style washers and three household style dryers. Two commercial washers and three commercial dryers to replace the household style appliances were identified to meet the needs at Fire Station 61. The appliances identified as Speed Queen commercial grade washers and dryers are used in high capacity at Park La Brea and have proven to be robust. The model of washers to be donated are Speed Queen Quantum Gold Pro top load washers Model #SWNNY2SP116TW01 at a cost of \$2017 per washer. The dryers to be donated are Speed Queen Quantum Gold Pro rear control single dryers Model #DGNYRGS116TW01 at a cost of \$1608 per dryer. Both models' specification sheets are attached.

Fire Station 61 consists of a Task Force, Paramedic and BLS Rescue, and an EMS Captain. With an upwards of 15 members per day at the fire station, there is a need for

reliable commercial grade washers and dryers to keep up with the demand of a large capacity station. The current station washers and dryers are old, frequently breaking down, and need to be replaced.


As a result of the current fire department staffing crisis, members are working more consecutive shifts and working from other fire stations which has increased the need for the use of the cleaning appliances. Additionally, with the increase in call load, having multiple units would assist in the ability for multiple members to be able to wash their clothes at the same time when they are ready to do so instead of waiting.


CONCLUSION

Having two reliable commercial grade washers and three dryers would greatly assist the members in maintaining clean uniforms, workout clothing and dish towels. The members at Fire Station 61 are grateful for the opportunity to accept such a useful donation by Park La Brea and WASH through the First-In Fire Foundation, and the approval to accept it would be greatly appreciated.

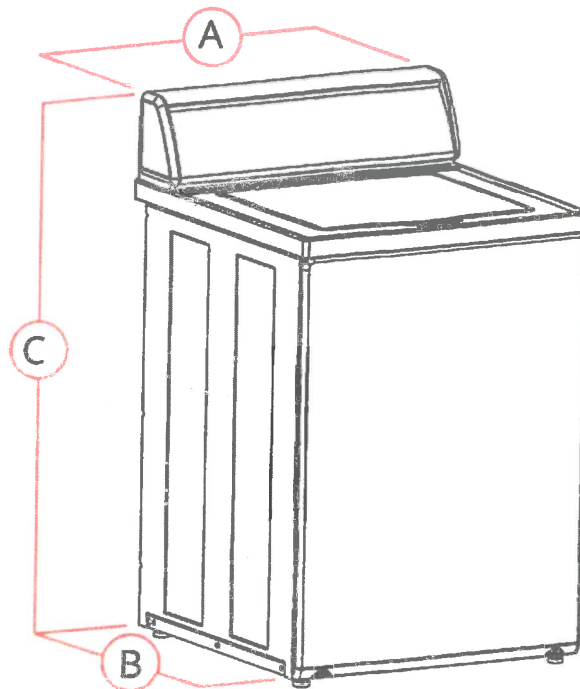

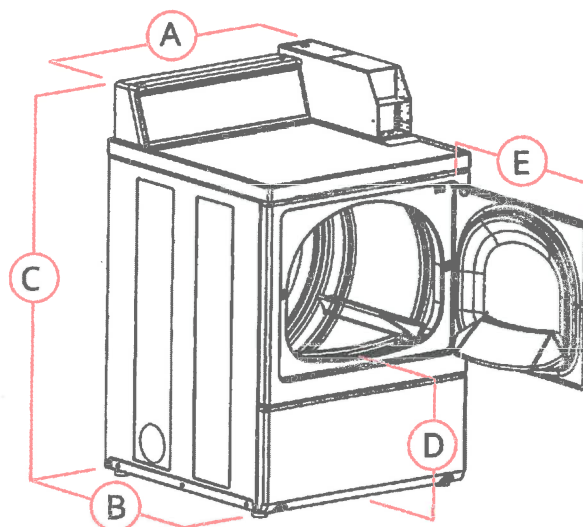
