Summary: The Bel Air-Beverly Crest Neighborhood Councils requests the City Council and City Attorney, when drafting and considering the council file item CF 22-0158, take into account the below requests: • Consideration of mandatory CEQA compliance. • Consideration of consequences of “Cutting red tape” by removing the public’s right to a transparent approval process including right to notification and the opportunity for public comment, including early notification to NCs and recognized CCs. • Consider the differences and effects of allowing shelters in R1 zones as proposed versus the existing ordinances allowing them in R2 & R3 zones. • Consideration of the effects of limiting shelters within a reasonable radius of sensitive sites such as parks, schools and daycares.
