Pursuant to your request, this Office has prepared and now transmits for your consideration the enclosed draft ordinance, approved as to form and legality. The draft ordinance would authorize the Department of Public Works (DPW) to use the design-build project delivery method and the competitive sealed proposal selection process for the Slauson Connect project (Project). The Project includes the construction of a community resource center and park along Slauson Avenue.

The design-build project delivery method will expedite the implementation of the Project in order to realize the benefits of the Project and to shorten the overall disruption that the City may experience during construction of the Project.
