

MOTION

The Los Angeles Parks Foundation (LAPF) is coordinating an effort for the acquisition of one of the last privately held parcels within Griffith Park. LAPF has raised funds to cover a significant portion of the cost to acquire the parcel and has asked Council District 4 to provide additional funds to meet the seller's asking price. Once acquired, the parcel will be donated to the City to enlarge Griffith Park.


Council District 4 has identified \$40,000 in Neighborhood Service Enhancement funds to assist LAPF with the purchase of the parcel.

I THEREFORE MOVE that \$40,000 be allocated from the Council District 4 portion of the "Neighborhood Service Enhancements" line item in the General City Purposes Fund No. 100-56 to the Los Angeles Parks Foundation (LAPF) to support the acquisition of one of the last privately held parcels within Griffith Park, which, once acquired, will be donated to the City to enlarge Griffith Park.

I FURTHER MOVE that the City Council direct and authorize the City Clerk to prepare, process, and execute the necessary document(s) with the LAPF, or any other agency or organization, in the above amount, for the above purpose, subject to the approval of the City Attorney as to form.

I FURTHER MOVE that the City Council request and authorize the City Controller, as well as the City Clerk, to waive any procedural and administrative requirements and/or policies in this matter and to process full payment as expeditiously as possible, inasmuch as time is of the essence for the acquisition of the subject property.
