PUBLIC WORKS COMMITTEE REPORT relative to granting a non-exclusive permanent easement on a portion of Reseda Park to the Bureau of Engineering (BOE) for public right-of-way purposes at the northwest corner of Reseda Boulevard and Victory Boulevard.

Recommendations for Council action:

- GRANT a non-exclusive permanent easement (Easement) to the BOE for public right-of-way purposes, on a portion of Reseda Park, at the northwest corner of Reseda Boulevard and Victory Boulevard.
- 2. ADOPT the accompanying RESOLUTION that approves the granting of the Easement to BOE that is further detailed in the Board of Recreation and Park Commissioners (Board) report dated March 17, 2022, attached to the Council file.
