
Section 1. The City Council of the City of Los Angeles finds that the public interest, convenience and necessity require that the name of that certain public street, 60 feet in width, being the first Northerly/Southerly trending public street easterly of Boyle Avenue, lying between 1st Street to Pennsylvania Avenue, or any portion of which may be or may have been named or known as or called Bailey Street be and the same is hereby changed to and established as Vicente Fernandez Street.

Sec. 2. Pursuant to the provisions of Section 252 of the Charter of the City of Los Angeles, this Ordinance shall become effective upon publication.

Sec. 3. The City Clerk shall certify to the passage of this ordinance and have it published in accordance with Council policy, either in a daily newspaper circulated in the City of Los Angeles or by posting for ten days in three public places in the City of Los Angeles: one copy on the bulletin board located at the Main Street entrance to the Los Angeles City Hall; one copy on the bulletin board located at the Main Street entrance to the Los Angeles City Hall East; and one copy on the bulletin board located at the Temple Street entrance to the Los Angeles County Hall of Records.
