**SUBJECT:** OFFICIAL POLICE GARAGE CONTRACT RENEWAL

### RECOMMENDATIONS

1. That the Board APPROVE and TRANSMIT to the City Council, the Executive Director's report recommending the renewal of the Towing and Storage Agreement for Official Police Garage (OPG), for Service Area 8, Quick Silver Towing, Inc., dba: Quick Silver Tow.
2. That the Board request AUTHORIZATION from the City Council for the President of the Board of Police Commissioners, or its designee, to negotiate and execute the renewal agreements with the affected OPG.

### DISCUSSION

Los Angeles Municipal Code Section 80.77.4(B)(5) states that "each OPG contract awarded pursuant to this section shall provide for an option to renew the contract for an additional five-year period subject to approval by the City Council."

The Commanding Officer of Commission Investigation Division (CID) has conducted a review of the OPG eligible for renewal and has determined that Quick Silver Tow has satisfactorily performed the work required by the contract, in compliance with federal, state and local laws.

A review of the complaint history for Quick Silver Tow revealed no serious violations or patterns of misconduct.
