Comments for Public Posting: CDC Director Dr. Rochelle Walensky has admitted a "dramatic mistake" and "resetting" the agency's reaction to Covid-19. The CDC admits that it made pretty public (faulty) mistakes from testing to data to communications. (Aug 23, 2022) The Biden Administration has ended its Covid-19 Testing Aimed at Unvaccinated Workers (Aug 17, 2022). The state of CA on its webpage (covid19.ca.gov) shows Masks are no longer required indoors in California, with a few expectations, as of April 22, 2022. There is no longer a "State of Emergency."
