Source of Activity:

On August 20, 2022, at approximately 0505 hours, my partner, Officer Baptista, Serial No. 39081, and I Officer Valle, Serial No. 44858, were working West Los Angeles Patrol, Unit 8A29, watch-3. We were in full uniform, driving a marked black and white police vehicle. We received a radio call of a 211 at 923 Broxton Ave. **Incident No. 22082000000770, RD 0817.**

Investigation:

Upon arrival we met with [REDACTED], Victim #1 who stated that on August 20, 2022 at approximately 0430 hours, he exited the Habibi Café with [REDACTED] (girlfriend/Victim #2) and got inside his vehicle that was parked 30 feet north (911 Broxton Ave) from the café. While preparing to drive home he was suddenly approached from the rear by two male black suspects who were armed with handguns. Suspect #1 approached Victim #1 from the driver's side window with a hand gun and he was described as a male, black, wearing a ski mask and a green long sleeve shirt. Suspect #2 approached Victim #2 from the passenger side window with a handgun and was described as a male, black, wearing a ski mask and a black shirt. Both suspects told the victims to give them all their things or they would get shot in the head. Victim in a state of fear complied with the suspects demands and gave them his phone, watch, backpack, and cross bag. Suspects took the victims property and fled on foot westbound on Le Conte Ave. Victim #1 observed a black vehicle ([REDACTED] black, Audi) that was parked behind them make a U-turn and possibly aid the suspects. Victims fled the location, but then came back after they had contacted police.

My partner interviewed [REDACTED] (Victim #2) who corroborated with the story Victim #1 gave and stated she was in fear for her life. The victim stated Suspect #2 had what appeared to be black long handgun possibly with a silencer attached. The Victim gave the suspects her Channel purse that contained her ID. Victim was terrified and believed there were three suspects but is unsure due to the trauma of the incident.

Victim #2 stated that her friend/witness [REDACTED] was across the street and took photos of a black vehicle that was parked behind their car. The victim stated that her friend/witness did not observe the robbery, but he did observe a black vehicle leave the location of the crime and took pictures. Vehicle license plate was [REDACTED]. She showed us a picture of the vehicle on her phone.

Unit 8A35-W3 Officer Gonzales, Serial No.40096 and Officer Blanco, Serial No. 44813 arrived at scene and assisted with my investigation.

I conducted a crime broadcast with all the descriptors provided by the victims. Suspect #1 a male, black, wearing a ski mask and a green long sleeve shirt, weapon used a semi-automatic Glock. Suspect #2 male, black wearing a ski mask and a black shirt, weapon used was a black semi-automatic Glock handgun with a silencer but was met with negative results.

We were able to contact [REDACTED] the manager of Habibi Café who stated she could provide video footage of the area the crime occurred.
