Source of Activity:

On Thursday, July 8, 2021, at approximately 0455 hours my partner (Officer K. Bedolla #44042) and I (Officer Z. Anderson #44041) were working West Los Angeles patrol, unit 8A95-W3. We were in full uniform, driving a marked black and white vehicle. We responded to a Battery Investigation at UCLA Westwood Hospital on 757 Westwood Plaza. Incident 2107080000578; RD 0818.

Investigation:

Upon our arrival at approximately 0500 hours, my partner and I met with a female (later identified as victim: [REDACTED]). [REDACTED] stated the following. She went to the hookah lounge (Habibi Café) on 923 Broxton Avenue with her friend (later identified as witness: [REDACTED]). [REDACTED] also invited a male she was dating (later identified as suspect: [REDACTED]). [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] were spending time together in the hookah lounge. However, [REDACTED] determined [REDACTED] was, "Mad disrespectful." [REDACTED] grabbed [REDACTED]'s throat using an unknown hand and strangled [REDACTED] in response. Security separated [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] by forcing [REDACTED] to exit the property. [REDACTED] followed [REDACTED] and hit her jaw with his hand. Security grabbed [REDACTED] attempting to deescalate, but [REDACTED] continued to hit [REDACTED] in the jaw. [REDACTED] was not sure how many times she was hit. [REDACTED] just remembers falling to the ground and seeing blood. She then realized she had a lot of pain in her jaw and in the back of her head. [REDACTED] then observed security allowing [REDACTED] to leave in what she believed to be an unknown type of a white Mercedes Benz 2 door sedan. [REDACTED] continuously asked security to remember the license plate but is unsure if they obtained the information. During the investigation, [REDACTED] was in a lot of pain and was hard to understand due to pain in her jaw.

My partner met with [REDACTED] and she stated the following. [REDACTED] brought [REDACTED] to the hookah lounge to meet [REDACTED] who was her boyfriend of 2 months. [REDACTED], [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] had an unknown amount of alcohol beverages. [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] had a verbal argument with [REDACTED] because they wanted to leave the club. Security had to escort [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] off the property. Once off the property, [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] continued to argue with [REDACTED]. [REDACTED] then punched [REDACTED]'s jaw with his right fist. [REDACTED] is unsure of what cheek he hit. [REDACTED] fled in a newer model white Lamborghini.

Our investigation revealed on 07/08/21 between the hours of 0100 to 0200, an argument ensued causing [REDACTED] to strangle [REDACTED] and then punch [REDACTED]'s jaw with his fist causing serious bodily injury.

Injury / Medical Treatment:

[REDACTED] was treated for pain in her jaw and pain in the back of her head at UCLA Westwood Hospital. Dr. Kadera treated injuries and advised [REDACTED]'s jaw is possibly broken.

Photographs/Recordings/Video/DICVS/Digital Imaging:

Our BWV were not utilized during the investigation due to the hospital setting. My partner took (5) photographs depicting [REDACTED]'s injuries. My partner uploaded the photographs to evidence.com. Habibi Café may have video surveillance which could have captured the incident.

This is a 211 PC courtesy report for LAPS WLA Division.

SOURCE OF ACTIVITY:

On 07/31/22, at approximately 0259 hours, I Officer Ruiz (#365) was working uniformed patrol for the UCLA Police Department. I was driving a marked, black and white, patrol vehicle (Unit 22).

STATEMENTS/OBSERVATIONS:

I was at the stoplight on Hilgard Avenue, south of Le Conte Avenue facing northbound when I observed two vehicles driving eastbound on Le Conte Avenue at a high rate of speed. They slammed on their brakes and immediately stop at the stoplight on Le Conte Avenue and Hilgard Avenue. Both vehicles were traveling so fast their tires screeched as they came to a complete stop. The first vehicle was a dark colored Kia (unknown license plate) with its headlights turned off. The second vehicle was a gray Dodge Charger (CA Lic [REDACTED]). The second vehicle was behind the first vehicle. When my light turned green, I turned left onto Le Conte Avenue, made a U-Turn and placed my vehicle behind the Charger to affect an enforcement stop. While waiting for the light to turn green, a black Toyota mini-van (CA Lic [REDACTED]) stopped on the right side of my vehicle. The driver of the Toyota and victim was later identified as [REDACTED] and the passenger of the Toyota and victim was identified as [REDACTED]. [REDACTED] told me they had just been robbed by the black Kia in front of us, and both suspects had guns. The dark Kia then drove through the red light and proceeded north onto Hilgard Avenue from Le Conte Avenue at a high rate of speed. I attempted to pursue the Kia. The light had turned green, but the Charger stayed stopped preventing me from driving around them to pursue the Kia. The victims drove on the right side of the charger and I maneuvered around the left side of the charger in an attempt to stop the Kia. Based on my initial observations and the driver's behavior, I believe the Charger was associated and actively working with the occupants of the Kia. By the time I turned onto Hilgard Avenue, I could no longer see the Kia. The victim traveled north on Hilgard Avenue from Le Conte Avenue and I followed. The victims pulled over on Malcom Avenue and Le Conte Avenue. Officer Embry (#336), Officer Amezcua (#357) and Sergeant Young (#327) responded to assist. I spoke with [REDACTED] who told me the following in summary:

On 07/31/22, at approximately 0257 hours, [REDACTED] and his cousin, [REDACTED] were at the Le Conte Parking Lot (10928 Le Conte Avenue), parked in the center of the parking lot facing southbound. [REDACTED] noticed the Kia was parked just north east of their location, in the same parking lot. [REDACTED] got out of the car and [REDACTED] stayed in the car. At that time, Suspect #1, described as a male Black, approximately 5'10", 170 pounds wearing a black "Pooh Shiesty" mask, black long sleeve shirt, black pants, holding a black Glock handgun, opened the driver side door and told [REDACTED] "Give it up, don't make me kill you." Suspect 1 had the handgun in his right hand and hit [REDACTED] on the right side of his head with the side of the pistol. Suspect 1 removed a white metal watch with diamonds on it from [REDACTED]'s left arm valued at approximately \$15,000.00 USD and [REDACTED]'s black, Gucci wallet containing his CDL and \$500.00. [REDACTED] valued the wallet at approximately \$300.00. Suspect 1 then ran back to his car and left the parking lot, east on Le Conte Avenue. [REDACTED] got back into their vehicle and they pursued the Kia. When the victims approached Hilgard Avenue, they saw me behind the vehicles and flagged me down.

Officer Amezcua spoke with [REDACTED] regarding the incident. Refer to Officer Amezcua's supplemental report for further information.

ADDITIONAL:

[REDACTED] denied medical attention on scene and is desirous of prosecution for 211 PC - Robbery.

On 07/31/2022, at approximately 0300 hours, I (Officer Amezcua #357) was assigned to patrol the University of California, Los Angeles, its affiliated properties and surrounding areas. I was in full regulation uniform, driving a marked black and white police vehicle.

At approximately 0300 hours, I responded to the area of Habibi Café (923 Broxton Ave) to assist Officer Ruiz-Perez #365 with a 211 PC - Robbery that just occurred. Sergeant Young #327 advised officers that a silver or grey Dodge Charger (Unknown license plate at the time) with no window tint and a black or blue Kia sedan (Unknown License Plate) were possibly involved, the weapon used was a firearm and property taken was jewelry.

OBSERVATIONS:

While searching the surrounding area for the suspect vehicles, Detective Arsena #369 advised that he was out with a 2022 grey Dodge Charger (CA License Plate # [REDACTED]) with no window tint to the rear of Fat Sal's Deli (972 Gayley Ave). The vehicle was occupied by two males. I responded to assist Detective Arsena.

Upon arrival, I ordered the driver ([REDACTED] - CA DL# [REDACTED]) and the passenger ([REDACTED] - CA DL# [REDACTED]) of the Charger out of the vehicle at gun point pending further investigation. Upon hand [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] they were told that they were not under criminal arrest, but being detained pending further investigation. [REDACTED] told me he understood.

[REDACTED] and [REDACTED] were returning to the Westwood area after being in Santa Monica. [REDACTED] stated that he was driving northbound on Gayley Ave from Wilshire Blvd when he observed a police vehicle behind him. [REDACTED] stated that he had not done anything bad, but understood the situation. [REDACTED] gave me consent to search the vehicle. Upon searching the vehicle, I did not locate any jewelry and determined that [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] were not the suspects involved in the robbery. Subsequently, Sergeant Young conducted follow-up investigation and determined that the license plate of the suspect Charger. The license plate did not match the license plate of [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] s Charger. [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] were released from the scene.

VICTIM STATEMENT: [REDACTED]

At approximately 0348 hours, I responded to the intersection of Le Conte Ave/Malcolm Ave to assist Officer Ruiz-Perez. I spoke to the second victim, [REDACTED], who told me the following in summary:

On 07/31/2022, at approximately 0257 hours, [REDACTED] and his cousin, [REDACTED] were parked (grey 2022 Toyota CA License Plate # [REDACTED]) in the Le Conte Parking Lot (10928 Le Conte Ave). [REDACTED] pulled southbound into the parking lot from Le Conte Ave and parked in the first stall, on the east corner of the south lane. [REDACTED] parked the vehicle facing southwest into the stall. While they waited for a third cousin to arrive, [REDACTED] exited the vehicle from the passenger side. [REDACTED] walked eastbound away from the vehicle.

As [REDACTED] began walking westbound back to the vehicle, he observed that a black Kia had parked directly behind their vehicle, and a silver 2021 Dodge Charger (CA License Plate # [REDACTED]) was parked to the rear of it. [REDACTED] walked between the Kia and [REDACTED]'s vehicle in order to get back into the passenger seat. Before [REDACTED] could get into the vehicle, an unknown suspect (Suspect #2), described as a black male, thin build, approximately 5'6 to 5'7 wearing a black hoodie, blue medical facemask, and black jeans, ran up behind [REDACTED]. Suspect #2 stood approximately 3 feet away from [REDACTED] and stated, "Give me everything". [REDACTED] stated that he contemplated running away, but realized that Suspect #2 was pointing a black 9mm handgun at him. Suspect #2 held the handgun with two hands. Suspect #2 told [REDACTED], "Don't move. Give me everything. Give me everything or I'll shoot". Fearing he would be shot, [REDACTED] handed the following property to Suspect #2:

- one gold ring with a crown and diamonds from his right pinky (unknown value)
- one gold Rolex ring from his left pinky (unknown value)
- one Cuban tennis bracelet (worth approximately \$3,500)
- Approximately \$1500 in US currency

Once Suspect #2 had obtained [REDACTED]'s property, he ran back into the rear passenger seat of the Kia. The Kia exited the parking lot and drove eastbound on Le Conte Ave with the Charger (CA License Plate # [REDACTED]) driving behind it. [REDACTED] told [REDACTED] to drive after the vehicles in attempt to get the license plate numbers. Upon arriving at the intersection of Le Conte Ave/Hilgard Ave, [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] observed and flagged-down Officer Ruiz-Perez (Refer to Officer Ruiz-Perez's report for additional information).

ADDITIONAL:

I asked [REDACTED] to send me images of the jewelry taken. At the time of this report, I have not received images of the jewelry. [REDACTED]'s interview and the incident at Fat Sal's were captured on my department issued body worn camera.
