TRANSPORTATION COMMITTEE REPORT and ORDINANCE FIRST CONSIDERATION relative to amending Los Angeles Municipal Code (LAMC) Section 71.29 to prohibit the Los Angeles Department of Transportation (LADOT) from disclosing mobility service data to any law enforcement agency, other than as required by law, pursuant to a lawfully issued subpoena or warrant.

Recommendation for Council action, SUBJECT TO THE APPROVAL OF THE MAYOR:

PRESENT and ADOPT the accompanying ORDINANCE dated September 1, 2022 amending Section 71.29 of the LAMC to add Subsection (c) to prohibit the LADOT from disclosing mobility service data to any law enforcement agency except when pursuant to a lawfully issued subpoena or warrant or as required by law.

<u>Fiscal Impact Statement</u>: None submitted by the City Attorney. Neither the City Administrative Officer nor the Chief Legislative Analyst has completed a financial analysis of this report.

Summary:

On September 6, 2022, your Committee considered a September 1, 2022 City Attorney report and Ordinance relative to amending LAMC Section 71.29 to prohibit the LADOT from disclosing mobility service data to any law enforcement agency, other than as required by law, pursuant to a lawfully issued subpoena or warrant. After consideration and having provided an opportunity for public comment, the Committee moved to approve the recommendation contained in the Motion.
