This Office recommends that discussions with, and advice from, legal counsel in this pending litigation be scheduled and held in closed session pursuant to Section 54956.9(d)(1) and (2) of the California Government Code. Government Code Section 54956.9(g) requires you to state publicly, prior to closed session, what subdivision of this section authorizes the closed meeting, and that the closed session is being held to confer, discuss with, or receive advice from, legal counsel regarding pending litigation.

These writ petitions filed by the 1516 Hobart, LLC and Lance Jay Robbins Paloma Partnership against the City of Los Angeles allege due process violations and state law preemption claims relating to the qualifications of Rent Adjustment Commissioners who serve on the Housing Appeals Board of the Los Angeles Housing Department.
