Recommendation for Council action, pursuant to Motion (Koretz - Ryu):

REQUEST the Los Angeles Department of Water and Power, with the assistance of the Chief Legislative Analyst (CLA), City Administrative Officer (CAO), and the City Attorney, to report on the number of installed stationary natural gas- and diesel-fueled distributed generation resources in Los Angeles and the feasibility of limiting the addition of such resources.

Fiscal Impact Statement: Neither the CAO nor the CLA has completed a financial analysis of this report.
