REQUEST the Los Angeles Department of Water and Power, and INSTRUCT the Chief Legislative Analyst (CLA), with the assistance of the Information Technology Agency, Bureau of Sanitation, Port of Los Angeles, Los Angeles World Airports and the City Administrative Officer (CAO), to report on the feasibility of developing and/or procuring Al technology and services to provide accurate and regular reporting and public disclosure of the City's organization-wide greenhouse gas footprint, as well as metrics on the City's progress toward achieving and exceeding the environmental goals presented in the 2019 Green New Deal Pathway.
