State law (commonly referred to as the "Caldera Bill") does not allow the State Department of Alcoholic Beverage Control (ABC) to issue a liquor license in cases where issuance would tend to create a law enforcement problem, be located in a high-crime area, or would result in or add to an undue concentration of licenses, unless the governing body of the affected city makes a finding that the granting of license would serve as a "public convenience or necessity."
