HOUSING COMMITTEE REPORT relative to authorizing the Community Investment for Families Department (CIFD) to apply for and accept a grant under the State Guaranteed Income Pilot Program through the California Department of Social Services (CDSS); and, to negotiate, execute, and submit a new grant agreement with the CDSS.

Recommendations for Council action, pursuant to Motion (Price – Martinez), SUBJECT TO THE APPROVAL OF THE MAYOR:

- AUTHORIZE the General Manager, CIFD, or designee, to apply and accept a grant in an amount up to \$5,000,000 under the State Guaranteed Income Pilot Program through the CDSS; and, to negotiate, execute, and submit the new grant agreement with CDSS, including all certifications and other required documents.
- 2. INSTRUCT the City Administrative Officer (CAO) to identify funding in the amount of \$1,500,000 in Fiscal Year (FY) 2023-2024 and \$1,000,000 in FY 2024-2025 to support the local, required match.
- 3. INSTRUCT the CIFD to report to the Council upon notice of the award to present the grant agreement and provide details on program design, staffing needs, Controller's instructions, and other relevant information for review and approval.

<u>Fiscal Impact Statement</u>: Neither the City Administrative Officer nor the Chief Legislative Analyst has completed a financial analysis of this report.

Summary:

At a regular meeting held on October 12, 2022, the Housing Committee considered Motion (Price – Martinez) relative to authorizing the CIFD to apply for and accept a grant in an amount up to \$5,000,000 under the State Guaranteed Income Pilot Program through the CDSS; and, to negotiate, execute, and submit a new grant agreement with the CDSS. The Motion also instructs the CAO to identify funding in the amount of \$1,500,000 in FY 2023-2024 and \$1,000,000 in FY 2024-2025 to support the local, required match; and, instructs the CIFD to report back upon notice of the award to present the grant agreement and provide details on relevant information for review and approval. After providing an opportunity for public comment, the Committee moved to adopt the recommendations contained in the Motion, as detailed above. This matter is now submitted to the Council for consideration.
