On January 8, 2022, 16-year-old Tioni Theus was found dead after drivers reported seeing her body along the southbound 110 Freeway in South Los Angeles. According to the County Coroner's Office, she had been shot in the neck. There was no apparent motivation. The suspect has not yet been identified and presents a significant peril to the community at large. Detectives are continuing to investigate this crime, but have not been able to identify any suspect or suspects. Detectives believe a reward may compel members of the public to provide information on the person or persons responsible for this crime. The person or persons responsible for this crime represent an ongoing threat to the safety of the people of Los Angeles; therefore, it is appropriate for the City of Los Angeles to offer a reward for information leading to the identification, apprehension and conviction of the person or persons responsible for this crime. Unless withdrawn or paid by City Council action, this offer of reward shall terminate on, and have no effect after, SEPTEMBER 1, 2022.
