RE: TRANSMITTAL FOR COUNCIL FILE NO. 20-1074

On October 4, 2022, the Planning and Land Use Management (PLUM) Committee considered a City Attorney report and Ordinance relative to amending the Los Angeles Municipal Code to using the Special Engineering Fee for certain Revocable Permit applications, and a Los Angeles Department of Transportation (LADOT) Application Review Fee for Revocable Permit applications for roadway dining areas. After providing an opportunity for public comment, the Committee recommended the following:

- 1. REFER Council file No.20-1074, to the Budget & Finance Committee (the Council file is pending in PLUM, Transportation, and Public Works Committees).
- 2. INSTRUCT the City Administrative Officer, with the assistance of LADOT, Bureau of Engineering (BOE), and the Department of City Planning, to prepare a report with recommendations as to a cost-benefit analysis of parking space and revenue loss; and positive/negative revenue impacts; inclusive in the analysis impact on the General Fund; and to also include in the analysis the impacts of the waiver of BOE and LADOT fees for projects that provide proof of economic hardship located within the JEDI; Promise; Opportunity; and Good Food Economic Development Zones.

The subject Council File is hereby transmitted to the Budget and Finance Committee for consideration. This matter awaits consideration by the aforementioned Committee.
