Honorable Members:

Pursuant to your request, this Office transmitted, on August 10, 2022, a draft ordinance (R22-0268) that would have added Section 71.30 to Article 1, Chapter VII of the Los Angeles Municipal Code (LAMC) authorizing the Department of Transportation (Department) to implement a Personal Delivery Device Pilot Program to regulate the operation and use of automated or remotely piloted personal delivery devices (PDDs), and issue permits to qualified pilot program operators as defined in the Department Rules and Guidelines.

After consideration, the Public Works Committee, on October 12, 2022, requested this Office make changes to the draft ordinance to revise Subsection (b) of Section 71.30 of the LAMC to add the Department and the Los Angeles Police Department (LAPD) as additional agencies that can enforce state or local laws that PDD operators violate in the City's public rights-of-way.
