

MOTION

Soil erosion has impacted a segment of Bedel Street in the Woodland Hills neighborhood which is in need of repair work to mitigate the erosion. The Bureau of Engineering (BOE) has prepared a repair plan that would involve removal of soil and the installation of K-rails. BOE estimates that the repair work will cost approximately \$53,000 and the City Administrative Officer has identified available funding from a completed project that has a remaining balance which can be used for this repair work.

I THEREFORE MOVE that the Bureau of Engineering (BOE) be directed to initiate a new capital improvement project to be known as the "Bedel Street Erosion Repair Project" for the removal of soil and the installation K-rails on a segment of Bedel Street in the Woodland Hills neighborhood that has been impacted by soil erosion.

I FURTHER MOVE that \$53,000 be transferred / appropriated, within SB1 Road Maintenance and Rehabilitation Special Fund No. 59V/50, from Account No. 50RKHT (Vista Del Mar 2,200-Ft& 3,000-Ft N/O Imperial Hwy Bulkheads) to New Account (Bedel Street Erosion Repair Project) to fund the above BOE Project.

I FURTHER MOVE that the City Administrative Officer be authorized to make any technical corrections or clarifications to the above fund transfer instructions in order to effectuate the intent of this Motion
