

PUBLIC WORKS COMMITTEE REPORT relative to installing protected bike lanes along Riverside Drive, east of Fletcher Drive in Council District 13, and continue them into Elysian Park along Stadium Way, and related matters.

Recommendations for Council action, pursuant to Motion (O'Farrell – Krekorian):

1. DIRECT the Los Angeles Department of Transportation (LADOT) to install protected bike lanes along Riverside Drive, east of Fletcher Drive in Council District 13, and continue them into Elysian Park along Stadium Way, following the route recommended in the City Bicycle Plan and the Elysian Park Master Plan.
2. DIRECT the LADOT and the Department of Public Works, in consultation with the City Administrative Officer (CAO), to report on the cost to install both the ADA sidewalk from Riverside Drive along Stadium Way into Elysian Park, which currently abruptly ends at Landa Street, and the recommended Pedestrian Activated Signalized Crosswalk at Elysian Park Drive and Stadium Way, as recommended in the Elysian Park Master Plan, which would assure the most underserved and mobility challenged residents safe passage and connectivity from the Los Angeles River through Elysian Park, to both active and passive recreation as well as the commercial centers of Downtown, Echo Park, and Dodger Stadium.

Fiscal Impact Statement: Neither the CAO nor the Chief Legislative Analyst has completed a financial analysis of this report.
