

ORDINANCE NO. _____

An Ordinance Initiating Proceedings to form the CITY OF LOS ANGELES STREETLIGHT MAINTENANCE ASSESSMENT DISTRICT NO. 5500, pursuant to the provisions of Sections 22500 et seq. of the Landscape and Lighting Act of 1972 and Article XIID of the California Constitution.

WHEREAS, the City Council, in accordance with and pursuant to the Landscaping and Lighting Act of 1972, Part 2, Division 15 of the California Streets and Highways Code (commencing with Section 22500), desires to initiate proceedings to establish a maintenance assessment district known and designated as CITY OF LOS ANGELES STREETLIGHT MAINTENANCE ASSESSMENT DISTRICT NO. 5500.

NOW THEREFORE,

**THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF LOS ANGELES
DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:**

Section 1. PROPOSAL. The City Council hereby proposes the formation of a maintenance assessment district designated as CITY OF LOS ANGELES STREETLIGHT MAINTENANCE ASSESSMENT DISTRICT NO. 5500, ("District") for the levy and collection of assessments pursuant to the provisions of Sections 22500 et seq., of the Landscape and Lighting Act of 1972 ("Assessment Law") and Article XIID of the California Constitution (Article XIID).

Sec. 2. ENGINEER'S REPORT. The Council hereby orders the Bureau of Street Lighting staff to prepare and file with the City Clerk the Engineer's Report concerning the District and the levy and collection of assessments for the fiscal year commencing July 1, 2023 and ending June 30, 2024 pursuant to Assessment Law (Sections 22565 et seq.) and Article XIID.

Sec. 3. IMPROVEMENTS. The improvements to be funded by the annual levy of assessments on property within the District shall be described in the Engineer's Report and shall include but not be limited to the following:


- (a) maintenance, servicing and operation of street lighting improvements;
- (b) the installation, construction or operation of any facilities which are appurtenant to any improvements listed in (a) or which are necessary or convenient for maintenance or servicing; and
- (c) administrative expenses of the City including all direct and indirect costs related to the levy and collection of assessments.

Sec. 4. The boundaries of the District are described as being all City streets with existing permanent street lights, within the boundaries of the City of Los Angeles.

Sec. 5. The City Clerk shall certify to the passage of this ordinance and have it published in accordance with Council policy, either in a daily newspaper circulated in the City of Los Angeles or by posting for ten days in three public places in the City of Los Angeles: one copy on the bulletin board located at the Main Street entrance to the Los Angeles City Hall; one copy on the bulletin board located at the Main Street entrance to the Los Angeles City Hall East; and one copy on the bulletin board located at the Temple Street entrance to the Los Angeles County Hall of Records.
