

ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT AND JOBS COMMITTEE REPORT and ORDINANCE FIRST CONSIDERATION relative to establishing protections for freelance workers.

Recommendation for Council action, SUBJECT TO THE APPROVAL OF THE MAYOR:

PRESENT AND ADOPT the accompanying ORDINANCE dated October 25, 2022 adding Article 10 to Chapter XVIII of the Los Angeles Municipal Code (LAMC) to establish protections for freelance workers.

Fiscal Impact Statement: None submitted by the City Attorney. Neither the City Administrative Officer nor the CLA has completed a financial analysis of this report.

Community Impact Statement: None submitted.

Summary:

On November 22, 2022, your Committee considered an October 26, 2022 BCA City Attorney report and Ordinance relative to establishing protections for freelance workers. On July 1, 2022, Council requested the City Attorney to prepare and present and Ordinance that would add Article 10 to Chapter XVIII of the LAMC to establish protections for freelance workers as detailed in the June 28, 2022 Economic Development and Jobs Committee report. After consideration and having provided an opportunity for public comment, the Committee moved to recommend approval of the Ordinance. This matter is now submitted to Council for its consideration.
