2023 Annual Report Little Tokyo Business Improvement District

District Name: This report is for the Little Tokyo Business Improvement District

Fiscal Year of Report: This report covers the period from January 1, 2023 to December 31, 2023.

Improvements and Activities for 2023: The Little Tokyo Business Improvement District (Little Tokyo BID) works to make the district a desirable location to conduct business and welcome visitors. The following are the improvements and activities planned for the Little Tokyo BID:

Safety Ambassador Program: The professional security program will consist of two safety officers patrolling on foot and on bicycles within the Little Tokyo BID boundaries a minimum of five (5) days per week. Hours of service shall be determined by the Little Tokyo BID board of directors.

Street/Sidewalk Maintenance Program: The street maintenance program shall consist of sidewalk and street clean up, tree trimming, gutter clearance to be conducted twice a month, trash hauling, and servicing of trash containers. Power washing of the sidewalks will be conducted periodically throughout the District in accordance with City guidelines.

Marketing and Promotional Program: The marketing and promotional program may consist of public events, cultural festivals, advertising, data analysis, surveys, public relations, and publicity geared toward strengthening the District's commercial economy and attracting new and returning customers. The program shall include maintenance of the Little Tokyo Business Association/Little Tokyo Business Improvement District website and production and distribution of the quarterly newsletter. New in 2023 will be: (1) the launch of an additional website designed for young people, K-12th grade, featuring a virtual tour, educational content, and cultural and language; and (2) establishment of the *Little Tokyo Legacy Business Registry*, a database comprised of the names and histories of local businesses that have been part of the Little Tokyo district for 30 years or more or have contributed significantly to the community's cultural character and sustainability.

Administrative Program: The expenditures anticipated in this area shall be for: professional accounting, consulting, and legal services, insurance premiums, office space, internet, and office equipment and supplies essential to the administration of the BID.

Total Estimate of Costs for 2023: It is the intention of the Little Tokyo BID managers to continue to provide safety, street maintenance, and marketing services within the District through 2023. The District's ability to provide such professional-level services

depends largely on the special assessments collected in support of the annual budget approved by the Little Tokyo BID Advisory Board (see Appendix A).

COVID-19 Negative Impacts. While the majority of the Little Tokyo business owners diligently paid their special assessment in 2020, 2021, and 2022, approximately 25 per cent of the business owners would not or could not pay their special assessments, citing economic hardships due to the COVID-19 pandemic. Additionally, about 30 businesses closed temporarily or permanently due to the pandemic, setting the stage for a revenue shortfall that the Little Tokyo BID management is still working to overcome.

Economic Hardship: The Little Tokyo BID Advisory Board is aware that merchants, especially those who operate small, independent businesses, were negatively impacted during 2020-2022 fiscal years by government-mandated restrictions related to the COVID-19 pandemic. With this in mind, the Little Tokyo BID has established a process by which members experiencing a period of financial hardship can request assessment adjustment. A subcommittee of the Little Tokyo BID will subsequently review all requests for relief in consultation with the City Clerk's office and advise the stakeholder of the determination. Those stakeholders seeking partial or full relief relative to the 2023 special assessment should submit requests in writing stating the reasons the reasons they are experiencing economic hardship. Requests must be submitted in writing via email to board@visittokyo.com or via U.S. Postal Service to the Little Tokyo Business Improvement District, 250 E. First St., Suite 201, Los Angeles, CA 90012.

Breakdown of the total estimated 2023 budget is attached to this report as Appendix A.

Assessment Methodology

For fiscal year 2023, to ensure that assessments are fairly assigned and applied, businesses of similar size and that are engaged in similar activities are grouped together and assessed a flat fee accordingly. Little Tokyo's proximity to the Civic Center, its long history as a popular downtown tourist area, and anticipated increase in the number of riders using Metro's new Little Tokyo/Arts District Regional Connector station amplify the need for heightened safety and cleanliness services. In addition, increases to the minimum wage, higher cost of living, increased costs of goods necessary to conduct business, and the loss revenue in prior years due to the pandemic, the Little Tokyo BID Advisory Board has decided to raise assessments by approximately twenty-five (25) percent in the 2023 operating year.

Definitions

Business: The term “business” shall mean any business, commercial enterprise, trade, calling, vocation, profession or any means of livelihood, whether or not carried on for gain or profit, within the Little Tokyo Business Improvement District boundaries.

Engaged in Business: The term “engaged in business” shall mean the conducting, operating, managing or carrying on of a business, whether done as an owner or by means of an officer, agent, manager, employee, servant or lessee of any of them, within the Little Tokyo Business Improvement District boundaries.

Person or Business Entity: The term “person” or “business entity” shall mean all domestic and foreign corporations, associations, syndicates, joint stock companies, partnerships of every kind, joint ventures, clubs, societies, non-profit organizations, and individuals engaged in any kind of business as defined herein, which shall include private, public, governmental agencies or *quasi* governmental agencies within the Little Tokyo Business Improvement District boundaries.

For fiscal year 2023, the BID special assessment for non-profit organization members will be as follows:

Nonprofit Organization Defined

For the purposes of the Little Tokyo Business Improvement District, a non-profit organization is defined as an entity, corporation, organization, association, etc. that has received a “tax exempt determination letter” from both the State of California - Franchise

Tax Board and the Department of Treasury - Internal Revenue Service; and has been designated as being one or more of the following type(s) of organizations:

Separate Assessment for Each Location

Every person who engages in any business activity, whether for profit or non-profit, within the Little Tokyo Business Improvement District boundaries which is subject to the special assessment shall be deemed to be engaged in a separate business at each branch establishment or location at which he/she engages in business and must make payment of the special assessment at each location or branch establishment within the Little Tokyo Business Improvement District boundaries from which the business activities are carried on.

Imposition of Special Assessment

The Little Tokyo Business Improvement District was created and established with the assistance of the local Little Tokyo, (business and nonprofit), community and is designed to exclusively benefit the local Little Tokyo community.

The annual special assessment shall be assessed to each and every person or business entity, business, nonprofit organization, (private, public, governmental agency, or *quasi* government agency), engaged in any business(es), occupation(s), etc. within the described boundaries of the Little Tokyo Business Improvement District boundaries. The billing and collection of the special assessment shall be the responsibility of the City of Los Angeles – Office of the City Clerk – Special Assessments Section – NBID Programs.

Due Date of Special Assessment

The annual BID Special Assessment shall be made payable to the Little Tokyo Business Improvement District in advance and remitted to the Office of the City Clerk – Special Assessment Section – NBID Programs and shall be due and payable when invoiced by the Office of the City Clerk.

When a business discontinues, dissolves, or otherwise terminates before the expiration of a BID Special Assessment period, any BID Assessment accrued and owing to the Little Tokyo Business Improvement District under the provisions of the Little Tokyo BID Ordinance, including any BID Special Assessment that would not otherwise be payable under the close of the BID Special Assessment period during which termination occurs, or until time for paying the BID Special Assessment for next succeeding BID Special Assessment period, shall be due on the date of termination.

When a business first becomes subject to the BID Special Assessment by reason of an amendment to the Little Tokyo BID Ordinance or, because of such an amendment, becomes subject to the BID Special Assessment under a section or basis not previously applicable to such business, any new or additional BID Special Assessment is required to be paid pursuant to the amended Little Tokyo BID Ordinance. As so amended, the BID Special Assessment shall be due and payable upon the effective date of the applicable Little Tokyo BID Ordinance unless an operative date different from the effective date of the amendment is specified therein.

The payment of the BID Special Assessment is not transferable upon the sale or transfer of a business to another party. Such a transfer shall not relieve the new owner from payment of the BID Special Assessment. For the purpose of sale or transfer of an existing business to another party, such acquiring party shall be treated as a “newly established business.” The BID Special Assessment to the new owner shall be made in accordance with the provisions of the “newly established business” section of the Little Tokyo BID Ordinance.

Late Penalty Assessment

The City of Los Angeles – Office of the City Clerk – Special Assessment Section – BID Programs will be responsible for the billing and collection of the Little Tokyo BID Special Assessment. The payment of the BID Special Assessment shall be made on a specified due date. Should payment not be received on or before the due date, late payments will be subject to a penalty of thirty percent (30%) of the amount due added in the first month of delinquency plus ten percent (10%) per month each month thereafter, not to exceed one hundred percent (100%) of the assessment amount due. Every penalty imposed and accrued shall become a part of the BID Special Assessment.

Exemption for Newly Established Businesses

New businesses that opened within the Little Tokyo BID after the notice of the required public hearing for the ordinance for levying the 2023 assessments was sent by the Los Angeles City Clerk will be exempt from the 2023 assessment; however, they will be subject to assessments in subsequent years. Any businesses that relocate within the BID year and remain within the BID area must pay their assessments, and the rolls will be updated.

Refunds of Special Assessment

No refund shall be allowed in whole or in part of the BID Special Assessment.

Exception: Should the Little Tokyo Business Improvement District be terminated by the City of Los Angeles, City Council, any non-committed or unused BID Special Assessment funds shall be refunded to those general LTBD members existing at the time of termination on a pro-rata basis of each member’s actual BID Special Assessment paid to the Little Tokyo Business Improvement District for the year prior to the year of termination. Any refunds to a particular member shall never exceed the actual BID Special Assessment paid to the Little Tokyo Business Improvement District by that particular member. Interest shall not accrue on any refund amount.

The City of Los Angeles – Office of the City Clerk – Special Assessment Section – BID Programs shall conduct a special audit of the Little Tokyo Business Improvement District to determine, if any, non-committed or unused BID Special Assessment funds. Upon the determination of non-committed or unused BID Special Assessment funds, the Office of the City Clerk – Special Assessments Section – BID Programs shall calculate, if any, each remaining members refund amount and cause, if any, to refund same to that member from the non-committed or unused BID Special Assessment funds.

Outside Sources of Revenue

The Little Tokyo Business Improvement District shall be permitted to solicit grants, accept voluntary contributions, conduct fundraising events, etc. for the purpose of raising additional sources of revenue to add to the members' special assessment funds to support the programs implemented by the LTBD. Funds raised through these sources shall go directly to the Little Tokyo BID administrative body and not through the Office of the City Clerk. Funds raised from these activities shall be for the exclusive use of the Little Tokyo BID programs.

Delinquent LTBD Assessment Fee

Delinquent accounts shall be handled according to the City of Los Angeles policy.

Amount of Surplus/Deficit from previous Fiscal Year:

It is anticipated that there will be no surplus carried over from 2022.

Amount of Contributions from other sources:

\$20,000 (grants, donor support, fundraising events)

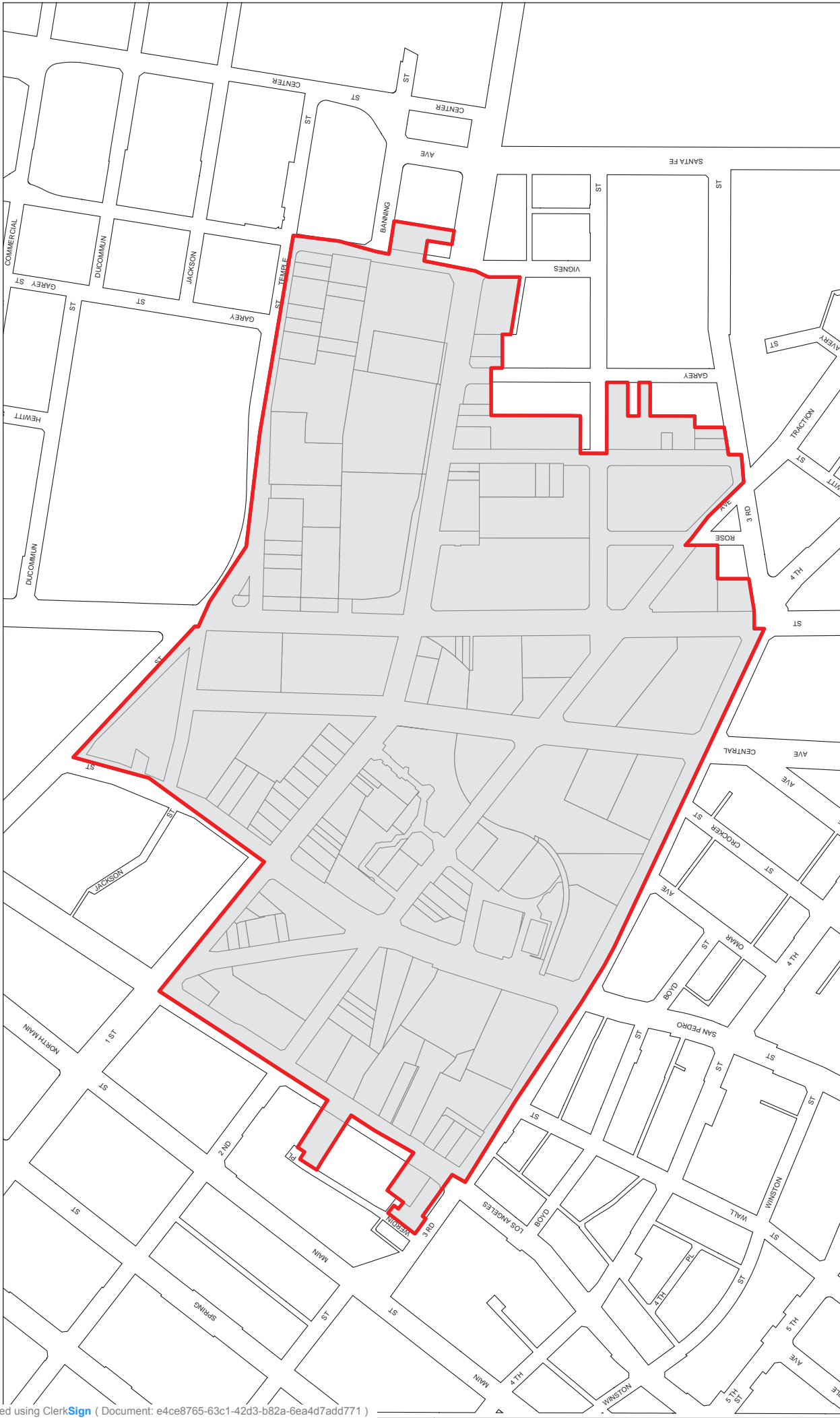
