RE: COUNCIL FILE TRANSMITTAL

On February 3, 2023, the Housing and Homelessness Committee considered CAO and Bureau of Engineering reports relative to lease extension for continued use of the Crisis and Bridge Housing at 1215 N. Lodi Place, 711 N. Alameda Street, and 11303 Pershing Avenue; and California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) exemption determinations that, consistent with the Notices of Exemption already in the City Council's prior actions (Council file Nos.19-0877, 18-0044 and 18-0510-S1 respectively); the projects are statutorily exempt under Public Resources Code (PRC) Section 21080(b)(4) as specific actions necessary to prevent or mitigate an emergency as also reflected in CEQA Guidelines Section 15269(c); and under PRC Section 21080.27 (AB 1197) applicable to City of Los Angeles emergency homeless shelters; and the 15th report regarding COVID-19 Homelessness Roadmap funding recommendations; and related matters, Council file No. 20-0841-S30. After consideration, the Committee moved to approve the following recommendations, as amended:

- APPROVE Recommendation Nos. 1 through 25 and Nos. 27 through 30, contained in the City Administrative Officer (CAO) report dated January 26, 2023, attached to Council file No. 20-0841-S30.
- 2. AMEND Recommendation Nos. 7 and 16, contained in the CAO report dated January 26, 2023, attached to the Council file, as follows:
 - 7. REQUEST the Los Angeles Homeless Services Authority to amend its Fiscal Year (FY) 2022-23 operation contracts with The People Concern in the amount of \$707,752.92 to reimburse for the operations costs gap for FY 2021-22.
 - 16. AUTHORIZE the transfer of up to \$72,000 of Homeless Housing, Assistance, and Prevention Round 2 (HHAP-2) Fund No. 64J/10, Account No. 10V753, CD 15 600 East 116th Place Tiny Home Village (THV) to HHAP-2 Fund No. 64J/10, in a new account entitled "6073 North Reseda Boulevard THV Pallets", of which \$72,000 has been expended and encumbered under a Purchase Order for pallet shelters that were meant for the project at 600 East 116th Place in Council District 15 and that will now be used for the THV at 6073 North Reseda Boulevard in Council District 3.
