Comments for Public Posting: I am so sad that I had to give up bike riding along the LA River, because the roads from my home, near first in Vermont to the LA river feel suicidal for a bike rider. In addition to the broken pavement, cars travel exceedingly fast, there are always trash cans in the right hand lane, and many people exiting cars on the driver side don't check for cyclists. These streets desperately need protected lanes for cyclists, and more frequent crossings for pedestrian safety. Many bicyclist like me prefer to use a crosswalk to make a left-hand turn, instead of taking the risk of biking against oncoming traffic. This is both a safety and an equity issue, because the bike way along the LA River provides one of the very few tranquil environments for someone living in a dense urban setting.
