## FIRST AMENDMENT TO AGREEMENT NO. 19-3678 BETWEEN THE CITY OF LOS ANGELES AND ARCADIS U.S., INC.

THIS FIRST AMENDMENT to Agreement No. 19-3678 is made and entered into by and between the CITY OF LOS ANGELES, a municipal corporation ("City"), acting by and through its Board of Harbor Commissioners ("Board"), and ARCADIS U.S., INC., as follows:

1. Paragraph 4.2 is amended to add two (2) years to the term of the Agreement as follows:

"4.2 The term of this Agreement shall not exceed seven (7) years commencing on the Agreement's effective date.

....

c. Seven (7) years have elapsed from the effective date of this Agreement."

2. Paragraph 5.1 is amended to add Two Million Dollars (\$2,000,000) to the compensation as follows:

"5.1 For the full and satisfactory performance of the Scope of Work, City shall pay Consultant and Consultant shall accept a sum not to exceed Four Million Dollars (\$4,000,000) to be paid as specified in <u>Exhibit "F."</u>"

Except as amended herein, all remaining terms and conditions of Agreement No. 19-3678 shall remain in full force and effect.
