SUB-AWARD - SECOND YEAR FUNDING

Attached is the Grant Acceptance Packet (Packet) for the California Victim Compensation and Government Claims Board, Joint Powers of Verification Unit (JPVU) grant sub-award in the amount of \$776,407 from the State Victim Compensation Claims Board (CalVCB) and the County of Los Angeles for the performance period of July 1, 2022 through June 30, 2023. This represents the second year of a three-year funding cycle that extends from July 1, 2021 through June 30, 2024.

The JPVU program assists victims of crimes with obtaining restitution for financial losses directly resulting from certain violent crimes. The total grant funding of \$776,407 will provide \$571,887 for salary costs for nine positions, as follows: one City Attorney Administrative Coordinator IV, one City Attorney Administrative Coordinator II, one Legal Clerk I, and six Witness Service Coordinators. The balance of grant funding will provide \$201,740 for related costs, \$1,560 for travel and training expenses, \$500 for equipment rental, and \$720 for telephone costs. There is no impact on the General Fund as the grant will cover the entire program cost. There is no match required for this grant.

As a participant in the Phase II eCivis Grants Management Program, the City Attorney's Office submitted the Packet for review and analysis by the Office of the City Administrative Officer (CAO) Grants Oversight Unit and the assigned CAO Analyst. This Office reviewed the Packet for completeness, conducted a concise analysis, prepared a Fiscal Impact Statement, and checked for compliance with the City's Financial Policies. The Packet consists of the following:

10. Grant Award Summary

The Office of the City Attorney requests approval to accept the FY2022-23 California State Victim Compensation Board (CalVCB) and County of Los Angeles grant sub-award of \$776,407 to support the Joint Powers of Verification Unit (JPVU) for a grant performance period of July 1, 2022 through June 30, 2023. There is no match requirement for this grant. This is the second year of a three-year funding cycle that extends from July 1, 2021 through June 30, 2024.

Under the State of California Government Code Section 13950, restitution may be provided to State residents who are victims of crimes from certain violent criminal acts. Under this provision, these victims of crimes may be eligible to receive monetary compensation for unreimbursed losses directly resulting from those crimes. The City's JPVU is responsible for the expedited verification and reimbursement of such claims filed by these victims of crimes within the City. In 2021-22, the JPVU processed 1,164 new claims and 4,012 bills related to medical and mental health expenses, loss of support, wage loss, funeral and burial costs, and relocation expenses. The value of FY 2021-22 claims processed exceeds \$1.45 million.

- 4. Authorize the City Attorney, or designee, to prepare Controller instructions for any necessary technical adjustments, subject to the approval of the City Administrative Officer, and authorize the Controller to implement the instructions.



The total cost of the program is \$920,773, of which \$776,407 is reimbursable to the City as follows: \$571,887 in salaries, \$201,740 in related costs, \$1,560 for travel and training expenses, \$500 for equipment rental, and \$720 for telephone costs. Reimbursement will be provided by the County of Los Angeles on a monthly basis. The grant award will finance nine positions as follows: one City Attorney Administrative Coordinator IV, one City Attorney Administrative Coordinator II, one Legal Clerk I, and six Witness Service Coordinators. The total related cost of \$346,106 includes \$249,228 for fringe benefits, \$24,820 for central services, and \$72,058 for departmental administration and support. The grant will cover \$201,740 for the fringe benefits costs while the remaining \$144,366 in related costs are included in the City Attorney's 2022-23 Adopted Budget. There is no additional impact to the General Fund.

Transmitted herewith for Mayor and City Council consideration is FY 2022/23 continuation funding totaling \$776,407 for year two of a three year grant term. Funding will maintain the Joint Powers of Verification Unit's (JPVU) operations to provide claims verification for crime victims for the period 7/1/2022 through 6/30/2023.

JPVU enhances the City's existing services by allowing the program to expedite the "Victims of Crime Compensation Claims" verification and reimbursement process for victims who are entitled to financial assistance. The JPVU grant is funded through the State Victim Compensation and Government Claims Board. Government Code Section 13959 states that it is in the public interest to assist residents of the State of California in obtaining restitution for the pecuniary losses they suffer as a direct result of criminal acts. Under this code, certain victims of crime may receive payment for unreimbursed losses directly resulting from a crime.

During FY 2021-2022 (**July 1, 2021** through **June 30, 2022**), JPVU processed 1,164 new claims and 4,012 bills related to medical/mental health expenses, loss of support, wage loss, funeral/burial and/or moving/relocation expenses for ongoing claims previously processed. The value of FY 2021-22 claims processed exceeds \$1.45 million.

These costs are associated with existing staff positions and are included in the adopted FY 22-23 budget.
