## **AMENDING MOTION**

I HEREBY MOVE that Council AMEND the accompanying Resolution attached to Motion 41A (Krekorian – Price), introduced for the matter of the possible ratification and related actions relative to the Mayor's Declaration of Emergency of March 14, 2023 concerning rainstorms causing flooding from extreme runoff and resulting in the partial collapse of a portion of a Los Angeles Aqueduct wall, pursuant to Los Angeles Administrative Code Section 8.2 (Item 41 on today's Council agenda), to adjust Paragraph 5 of said accompanying Resolution by inserting reference to Charter section 371 as follows:

5. Insofar as the public interest and necessity demand the immediate expenditure of public funds to safeguard life, health, or property in response to the local emergency and mitigation efforts related to the local emergency, the City Council hereby approves and resolves that the competitive bidding restrictions enumerated in Charter sections \*371 and 372, and Los Angeles Administrative Code sections 10.15 and 10.17 be suspended until April 21, 2023 or the termination of the state of emergency, whichever comes first, for the Los Angeles Department of Water and Power (LADWP) to authorize and order any action relative to the procurement of construction contracts, supplies, and equipment but only if monies for related payments be drawn from LADWP's proprietary funds; and
