PUBLIC SAFETY COMMITTEE REPORT relative to an overview of the Los Angeles Police Department's (LAPD) response to domestic violence incidents and information relating to domestic violence; and enforcement of gun relinquishment provisions of court orders; and related matters.

Recommendation for Council action, pursuant to Motion (Park – Rodriguez):

DIRECT the LAPD to:

- a. Provide an overview of the LAPD's response to domestic violence incidents, providing relevant statistics such as the number of incidents per year, procedures for response and any other information tracked relating to domestic violence.
- b. Report on challenges to enforcing gun relinquishment provisions of court orders and best practices implemented in other jurisdictions relating to firearm restraining order enforcement.
- c. Report on new Domestic Violence Restraining Order enforcement procedures as they relate to Senate Bill (SB) 320 as well as the additional resources needed to adequately address any potential increase in Gun Violence Restraining Order enforcement resulting from SB 320.
