

CATEGORICAL EXEMPTION, NEIGHBORHOODS AND COMMUNITY ENRICHMENT COMMITTEE REPORT, and ORDINANCE FIRST CONSIDERATION relative to approving the establishment of a street in Reseda Park, and related matters.

Recommendations for Council action, SUBJECT TO THE APPROVAL OF THE MAYOR:

1. DETERMINE that the City's action approving the establishment of a street in Reseda Park is categorically exempt from California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) pursuant to Article III, Section 1, Class 1(3) [Minor alterations of highways and streets sidewalks, gutters, bicycle and pedestrian trails, and similar facilities] and Class 1(14) [Issuance of a license or permit to use an existing property involving negligible or no expansion of use] of City CEQA Guidelines and Article 19, Section 15301 of California CEQA Guidelines.
2. PRESENT and ADOPT the accompanying ORDINANCE dated January 31, 2023, approving the establishment of a street in Reseda Park.

Fiscal Impact Statement: None submitted by the City Attorney. Neither the City Administrative Officer nor the Chief Legislative Analyst has completed a financial analysis of this report.

Community Impact Statement: None submitted.

Summary:

On April 19, 2023, your Committee considered the City Attorney report, and Ordinance dated January 31, 2023, relative to approving the establishment of a street in Reseda Park. The report and ordinance attached to the Council file include some background on the matter. After providing an opportunity for public comment, the Committee moved to approve the recommendations reflected above. This matter is now forwarded to the Council for its consideration.
