## **SUMMARY**

At its regular meeting held on April 25, 2023, your Government Operations Committee considered an MFC report, dated March 21, 2023, relative to a license agreement with Per Scholas at 1600 East 4th Street, Los Angeles, CA 90033.

On June 29, 2022, City Council adopted the Annual Plan Fiscal Year 23 for Program Year 2022-23, attached to Council file No. 22-0683. The adopted report gave the Economic & Workforce Development Department (EWDD) authority to negotiate and execute Memoranda of Understanding (MOUs) and amendments to MOUs with the City-operated YouthSource Centers to provide services to youth. City-operated YouthSource Centers' goals are to provide young Angelenos ages 14 to 24 with resources to advance in school and their careers. EWDD has identified Per Scholas as a capable YouthSource Operator at their YouthSource location on 1600 East 4<sup>th</sup> Street, Los Angeles, CA 90033. Per Scholas will operate out of approximately 1,500 square feet of space at the City-owned facility located at 1600 East 4<sup>th</sup> Street in Los Angeles, also referred to as the Boyle Heights Technology Center.

After an opportunity for public comment was held, the Committee moved to approve the recommendation in the MFC report, as detailed above. This matter is now forwarded to the Council for its consideration.
