On 04/08/23 at approximately 2105 hours my partner, (Officer Munoz Serial No. 45159) and I, (Officer Collver Serial No. 43037) were working Southeast Div Patrol as 18A17-W3. We were in full uniform driving a marked black and white police vehicle when we received multiple R/C's of ADW Shooting just occurred in the area of W. Century Blvd. and 110 Fwy. North. Comments stated, "MALE W/ VICT OF SHOOTING, LINE DISCONNECTED UPON TRANSF TO FD. MALE POSS PUTTING VICT INSIDE A VEH, REF TO ANSWER QUESTIONS, FD HAD CALL AT LOC FOR MALE BLEEDING, FD NOW STAGING AT LOC. ATT C/B TO PR, 415 W/ EBO, VICT TAKEN TO UNK HOSP IN UNK VEH."

Investigation:

Upon arrival, Officers were unable to locate any evidence of a shooting, a Victim, or Suspects. My partner and I were advised by a female that she observed a Male, Hispanic, with a blood stained White T-shirt running northbound from Flower across Century Blvd. towards 711. I requested dispatch notify LA County Med Alert for any Victims of a gun shot wound.

At approximately 2200 hours Officers received notification from security at MLK Hospital that Victim had self transported to MLK Hospital and was in route to St. Francis Medical Center.

I spoke with RP (Campos, Employee #453027) over the phone who stated that he is an off duty LA County Sheriff deputy working an overtime security shift at MLK Hospital. Campos stated that at approximately 2130 hours an unknown vehicle pulled up to the ER with Victim and Victim 2. Victim had a GSW to his left shoulder. Campos stated that he was advised by Victim that the shooting occurred at 400 W. Century Blvd. at the Magic Carpet Inn. Campos was unable to acquire further info due to Victim 1 requiring immediate transport to St. Francis Medical Center.

My partner and I followed up to St. Francis Medical Center and met with Victim 1 ([REDACTED]). [REDACTED] stated that at approximately 2000 hours he was hanging out with Victim 2 (Cousin) when they met a female (NFD). They went to an unknown gas station and bought beer. [REDACTED] and his cousin then went to 400 W. Century Blvd (Magic Carpet Inn) and hung out with a female inside a room on the bottom level. The door to the room was left slightly ajar. Randomly a Male, Black Ski Mask (NFD) entered through the open door and demanded Victim 1 and Victim 2 property. Victim 1 in fear tossed his car keys, wallet, phone, and U.S.

Currency on to the bed. [REDACTED] stated that out of nowhere he heard a ringing in his left ear and observed blood seeping through his shirt. [REDACTED] became scared and fled location on foot with Victim 2. A random citizen driving in the area observed [REDACTED] and Victim 2 and gave them a ride to MLK Hospital. Victim 1 was unable to provide any further information.

I met with Victim 2 ([REDACTED]) inside St. Francis Medical Center front Lobby. Victim 2 stated that at approximately 2000 hours he met a Female (NFD) with Victim 1. Victim 2 and Victim 1 bought beer and entered a room on the bottom story of the Magic Carpet Inn (400 West Century Blvd.) Victim 2 advised that the door to the room was left slightly open. Victim 2 stated that as they were hanging out Suspect 1 (described as Male, Black, 20-30 yrs old, BLK Ski Mask, thin build) and Suspect 2 (described as Male, Black, 20-30 yrs old, BLK ski mask, slightly heavy build) entered the room through the front door and demanded Victim 1 and Victim 2 belongings. Victim 2 observed both Suspects armed with a BLK semi-auto handgun in their right hands. Victim 2 in fear tossed his wallet, car keys, and U.S. Currency on to the bed. Suspect 1 then struck Victim 2's face with a handgun and struck Victim 2's face with closed fist. Victim 2 observed Suspect 2 pointing a BLK semi-auto handgun towards Victim 1's chest from approximately 5 ft away. Suspect 2 then fired one round striking Victim 1 in the left shoulder area. Victim 2 in fear grabbed Victim 1 and they fled the room and then hopped a wall out of the parking lot of the Magic Carpet Inn. Victim 2 then peered over the wall and observed Suspect 1 and Suspect 2 enter a Dark Green Older Model Chrysler 300 and exit the hotel parking lot in unknown direction.

Injury/Medical Treatment:

Victim 1 had a single gun shot wound to his left shoulder area. Victim 1 self transported to MLK Hospital and then was transported by unknown RA to St. Francis MED Center. Victim 1 was seen and treated by DR. Edward Kwon. MRN# 114261913.

Officers did not observe any visible injuries to Victim 2. Victim 2 refused medical treatment.

Canvassing:

18A25-W3 (Officer Simental #43708 and Officer Fabri #45077) followed up to 400 W. Century Blvd, Magic Carpet Inn to canvass for additional evidence, witness's, Suspects, and video surveillance. Officer Simental met with Motel manager and advised that the manager was uncooperative with Officers investigation and refused to provide video surveillance and access to room logs. Officer Simental was unable to locate which room Victims were in. Officer Simental located a truck matching the description of Victim 1's truck (Dark Gray, Chevy, Silverado, shiny rims) that was left in the parking lot of the location. Victim 1 stated he would have AAA tow his truck at a later time.
