**Comments for Public Posting:** The Mills Act is the single most important economic incentive program in California for the restoration and preservation of qualified historic buildings. Mills Act contracts should continue to be automatically renewed each year especially when transferred to new owner to ensure the property continues to be restored, maintained, and protected in accordance with specific historic preservation standards and conditions (both interior and exterior!). If the City unwisely cancels or diminishes these contracts, property owners (especially the new ones) will have very little incentive to preserve these important architectural resources. Cancelling or deflating Mills Act contracts will have the opposite effect of preserving these resources! Please listen to the recommendations of the LA Conservancy!
