## **VERBAL MOTION**

I HEREBY MOVE that Council APPROVE the recommendations of the City Clerk (Item #4, Council file 09-2013) relative to the renewal of the Highland Park Property Business Improvement District, SUBJECT TO THE APPROVAL OF THE MAYOR;

- FIND that the petitions submitted on behalf of the proponents of the proposed Highland Park Property BID are signed by property owners who will pay more than 30 percent of the assessments proposed to be levied.
- 2. ADOPT the Preliminary Report of the City Clerk, as attached to the Council file.
- 3. ADOPT the Management District Plan, as attached to the Council file.
- 4. ADOPT the District Assessment Engineer's Report, as attached to the Council file.
- 5. FIND that all parcels that will have a special benefit conferred upon them and upon which an assessment would be imposed are those identified in the Management District Plan and attached to the Council file.
- 6. FIND that in accordance with Article XIIID of the California Constitution and based on the facts and conclusions contained in the District Assessment Engineer's Report, as attached to the Council file, that the assessment levied on each parcel within the proposed the Highland Park Property BID is proportionate to the special benefit derived from the improvements and activities that are to be provided.
- 7. FIND that in accordance with Article XIIID of the California Constitution and based on the facts and conclusions contained in the District Assessment Engineer's Report, as attached to the Council file, that there are no general benefits to be separated from the special benefits conferred on each parcel within the proposed District.
- 8. FIND that in accordance with Article XIIID of the California Constitution and based on the facts and conclusions contained in the attached District Assessment Engineer's Report, as attached to the Council file, that no assessment imposed on any parcel exceeds the reasonable cost of the proportional special benefit conferred on that parcel.
- 9. AUTHORIZE the City Clerk, upon establishment of the Highland Park Property BID, to prepare, execute and administer a contract between the City of Los Angeles and a nonprofit corporation for the administration of the District's programs.

- 10. PRESENT and ADOPT the accompanying ORDINANCE OF INTENTION to establish the Highland Park Property BID.
- 11. APPOINT the Advisory Board as detailed in the Preliminary Report of the City, attached to the Council file.
- 12. DIRECT the City Clerk to comply with the notice, protest, and hearing procedures prescribed in the Proposition 218 Omnibus Implementation Act (California Government Code, Section 53750 et seq.).
- 13. REQUEST the City Attorney, with the assistance of the City Clerk, to prepare and present an enabling Ordinance establishing the Highland Park Property BID for Council consideration at the conclusion of the required public hearing.
