**Comments for Public Posting:** I sincerely hope Traci Park's ludicrous motion to rubber stamp the mass eviction of people from rent stabilized units at Barrington Plaza will not be seriously considered. Why should people who work at UCLA or any of the businesses in this district have to commute from the valley to be able to afford housing? Los Angeles is a city of renters, we need a city government that protects our interests, not the interests of big real estate like Douglas Emmett. There absolutely is a pathway to force Douglas Emmett to do the necessary repairs to their building and keep it affordable for renters.
