Honorable Members:

This Office has prepared and now transmits for your consideration, approved as to form and legality, the enclosed draft ordinance for the 2023 season determining that certain weeds, rubbish, refuse, and dirt on certain streets, sidewalks, and parkways, and on, or in front of, certain private properties in the City are a public nuisance, and declaring the intention of the City Council to order the abatement of these nuisances.

This ordinance has been prepared in accordance with the provisions of California Government Code Sections 39560 through 39588. The ordinance fixes the date of August 1, 2023, for the City Council to hear any objections to the proposed abatement of each such nuisance.



Council Rule 38 Referral


