In accordance with Proposition 218, the City of Los Angeles provided notice to the property owners of the parcels in the proposed Normal Avenue and Virgil Avenue Lighting District, as specified in the subject Council File. Along with that notice, each property owner received an assessment ballot weighted by the amount of the parcel's proposed assessment. I have tabulated the assessment ballot delivered to my office by the final hearing date of June 20, 2023.
