RULES, ELECTIONS, AND INTERGOVERNMENTAL RELATIONS COMMITTEE REPORT and RESOLUTION relative to establishing the City's position regarding Assembly Bill 1738 (Carrillo) which would require the Department of Motor Vehicles (DMV) to establish the Mobile Homeless Connect Pilot Program in specified areas to assist persons experiencing homelessness with obtaining identification cards.

Recommendation for Council action, pursuant to Resolution (Raman – Soto-Martinez), SUBJECT TO THE CONCURRENCE OF THE MAYOR:

RESOLVE to include in the City's 2023-24 State Legislative Program SUPPORT for Assembly Bill 1738 (Carrillo) which would require the DMV to establish the Mobile Homeless Connect Pilot Program in specified areas to assist persons experiencing homelessness with obtaining identification cards.

## <u>SUMMARY</u>

At a meeting held on June 23, 2023, the Rules, Elections, and Intergovernmental Relations Committee considered a Chief Legislative Analyst report and Resolution (Raman – Soto-Martinez) Assembly Bill 1738 (Carrillo) which would require the DMV to establish the Mobile Homeless Connect Pilot Program in specified areas to assist persons experiencing homelessness with obtaining identification cards.

After providing an opportunity for public comment, the Committee recommended that Council adopt the Resolution. This matter is now forwarded to Council for its consideration.
