There has been 3 fires on the property located at 1537 Cambria Street, Los Angeles, CA 90017. My adjacent property was damaged during the first and second fire. I have smoke damage and cracked windows. Then too, the smoke is in the air that we are breathing. All of this has had an adverse impact on our health, safety, and the environment. I'm requesting that the apartment that will be built in the near future won't be so close in proximity to my home. If you allow this to move forward without making any changes such as reverting back to the 4,550 square feet of open space as required by LAMC Section 12.21 G.2, I fear that my house that was built in 1900, will burn down one day.
