

TRANSPORTATION COMMITTEE REPORT and RESOLUTION relative to the prohibition of the parking of vehicles that are in excess of 22 feet in length or over 84 inches in height during the hours of 2:00 am and 6:00 am along various street segments in Council District Ten (CD 10).

Recommendations for Council action, pursuant to Resolution (Hutt – Park):

1. PROHIBIT, pursuant to Los Angeles Municipal Code Section 80.69.4 and California Vehicle Code Section 22507, the parking of vehicles that are in excess of 22 feet in length or over seven feet in height, during the hours of 2:00 am and 6:00 am along both sides of the following street segments:
 - a. Sawyer Street between La Cienega Boulevard and South Holt Avenue
 - b. South Holt Avenue between West 18th Street and Sawyer Street
 - c. West 18th Street between La Cienega Boulevard and South Holt Avenue (south side only)
2. DIRECT the Los Angeles Department of Transportation (LADOT), upon the adoption of the Resolution, to post signs giving notice of a "tow away, no parking" restriction for oversized vehicles, with the specific hours detailed, at the above locations.
3. AUTHORIZE the LADOT to make technical corrections or clarifications to the above instructions in order to effectuate the intent of this Resolution.

Fiscal Impact Statement: Neither the City Administrative Officer nor the Chief Legislative Analyst has completed a financial analysis of this report.

Community Impact Statement: None submitted.

Summary:

On August 16, 2023, your Committee considered a Resolution (Hutt - Park) relative to the prohibition of oversized vehicles parking along various street segments in CD 10. According to the Resolution, there is an increased problem with oversized vehicles parking along several street segments where large vehicles are often parked overnight and constrict travel lanes, thereby creating dangerous situations. Pursuant to LAMC Section 80.69.4, and California Vehicle Code Section 22507, it is proposed that the parking of vehicles that are in excess of 22 feet in length or over 7 feet in height, during the hours of 2:00 am and 6:00 am, be prohibited along the street segments as detailed in Recommendation No. 1. After consideration and having provided an opportunity for public comment, the Committee moved to approve the Resolution. This matter is now submitted to Council for its consideration.
