Hello Councilman Bonin, I hope you are well.

Well intended initiatives will have negative unintended consequences. A one size fits all ordinance does not work for all businesses.

Three ordinances will be voted on tomorrow that are of concern to the business community:

Right of Recall Ordinance (Written Comment Number: 20-0147-S15)

- Retroactive to March 4, 2020 and in effect until March 4, 2022
- Ensures priority re-hiring by seniority to those laid off due to COVID-19.

Citywide Worker Retention Ordinance (Written Comment Number: 20-0147-S35)

- In a change of control scenario, successor business are required to rehire and retain employees
- There is no sunset clause for the ordinance

Supplemental Paid Sick Leave (Written Comment Number: 20-0147-S39)

- Businesses must provide 80 hours of sick leave to employees during the COVID-19 pandemic
- Sunsets on December 31, 2020

As we engage with businesses who are cash strapped and struggling to survive, layering regulations that will take them into a deeper economic crisis is of great concern.
