REVISED DRAFT ORDINANCE ADDING ARTICLE 2-72TT TO CHAPTER XX OF THE LOS ANGELES MUNICIPAL CODE REQUIRING RETAIL FOOD STORES TO DEDICATE ONE HOUR OF CUSTOMER BUSINESS EXCLUSIVELY TO ELDERLY AND THE DISABLED

Honorable Members:

On March 25, 2020, our Office transmitted a draft ordinance that would add Article 2-72TT to Chapter XX of the Los Angeles Municipal Code to require a retail food store to dedicate the first hour, or in the case of a store that is open 24-hours, at least one hour in the morning, exclusively to customers who are elderly, disabled, or operators of congregate living homes that serve the elderly and disabled. We are transmitting this revised draft ordinance, approved as to form and legality, to correct one word in the definition of "Retail Food Store."
