Pursuant to your request, this Office has prepared and now transmits for your consideration the enclosed draft ordinance, approved as to form and legality. The draft ordinance adds Article 2-72TT to Chapter XX of the Los Angeles Municipal Code to require a retail food store to dedicate the first hour, or in the case of a store that is open 24-hours, at least one hour in the morning, exclusively to customers who are elderly, disabled, or operators of congregate living homes that serve the elderly and disabled.
