MOTION

I HEREBY MOVE that the Council ADOPT the following recommendations in order to effect settlement in the case entitled <u>Blanca Avila v. City of Los Angeles</u>, et al., Los Angeles Superior Court Case No. BC684155. (This matter arises out of the alleged discrimination on the basis of a disability and retaliation that occurred in 2015 to 2016 within the Los Angeles Police Department.) **SUBJECT TO THE APPROVAL OF THE MAYOR:**

- 1. AUTHORIZE the City Attorney's Office and the Los Angeles Police Department to expend up to **\$1,300,000** in settlement of the above-entitled matter.
- 2. AUTHORIZE the Controller's Office to transfer \$1,235,000 from the Liability Claims Fund No. 100/59, Account No. 009798, Miscellaneous Liability Payouts, to Fund No. 100/59, Account No. 009792, Police Liability Payouts.
- 3. AUTHORIZE the City Attorney to draw a demand from Fund No. 100/59, Account No. 009792, Police Liability Payouts, as follows: McNicholas & McNicholas LLP Client Trust Account in the amount of \$1,235,000.
- 4. AUTHORIZE the Los Angeles Police Department to draw a demand from Fund No. 100/70, Account No. 001012, Sworn Salaries, payable to Blanca Avila, for back wages in the amount of \$65,000, as gross wages subject to all applicable taxes, payroll deductions, and withholdings.
- 5. INSTRUCT the City Clerk to place on the agenda for the first regular Council meeting on July 1, 2023, or shortly thereafter, the following instructions:
 - a. Authorize the Controller's Office to transfer \$1,235,000 from the Liability Claims Fund No. 100/59, Account No. 009798, Miscellaneous Liability Payouts, to Fund No. 100/59, Account No. 009792, Police Liability Payouts during the next fiscal year 2023-24.
- AUTHORIZE the City Attorney, or designee, to make necessary technical adjustments, subject to the approval of the City Administrative Officer, and authorize the Controller to implement the instructions.
