

PUBLIC SAFETY COMMITTEE REPORT relative to acceptance of a non-monetary donation valued at \$201,141.12 of Digital Interview Room Capture Stations for the Los Angeles Police Department (LAPD) Technical Investigation Division.

Recommendation for Council action:

APPROVE the acceptance of the non-monetary donation valued at \$201,141.12 for Digital Interview Room Capture Stations from the Los Angeles Police Foundation for the LAPD Technical Investigation Division; and THANK the donor for this generous donation.

Fiscal Impact Statement: None submitted by the Board of Police Commissioners (Board). Neither the City Administrative Officer nor the Chief Legislative Analyst has completed a financial analysis of this report.

Community Impact Statement: None submitted.

Summary:

On September 12, 2023, your Committee considered a June 9, 2023 Board report relative to acceptance of a non-monetary donation valued at \$201,141.12 of Digital Interview Room Capture Stations Los Angeles Police Department (LAPD) Technical Investigation Division. According to the Board, the donation will provide Digital Interview Room Capture Stations for the 62 interview rooms located throughout LAPD facilities. Many of the audio/video recording systems currently in use within the rooms are outdated and no longer serviceable. The new equipment will capture evidentiary grade video, have a full audit trail to ensure chain of custody for the original recording, and be fully networkable.

Approval of this donation will ensure that investigators have access to interview rooms with reliable recording systems. The purpose and capabilities of the interview rooms remain unchanged. All newly acquired audio/video recording systems will be reported per the LAPD's Acquisition and Annual Reporting of Certain Information Systems and Technologies policy. After consideration and having provided an opportunity for public comment, the Committee moved to recommend approval of the donation as detailed in the Board report. This matter is now submitted to Council for its consideration.
