Dear Mr. Gallagher,

The Los Angeles Police Department has been working with the community and the staff from Council District 14 to address issues related to criminal activities in the Lincoln Heights area. The gang activities, use and sales of narcotics and public drinking have caused a drastic rise in crime. Based on our investigation, it has been determined that parked vehicles on the following street segments are contributing to a crime problem in the area, and that continuing to allow parking/stopping on this block would be a detriment to the public welfare:

1. Valley Blvd. from Soto to Mission Road;

Section 80.69 of the Los Angeles Municipal Code authorizes the Department of Transportation to prohibit the stopping of parking of vehicles when the unrestricted parking of vehicles would create a hazard of detrimentally affect the public welfare. Please accept this letter as a validation of such a condition. Due to the increase in violent crime in this area, it is requested that the Department authorize and install "No Overnight Parking For Oversized Vehicles" restrictions for the locations specified above, to be in effect at all times.
